- Economical and familiar issues
- Relationship and couple issues
- Scarce attention for the siblings (brothers and sister of disabled children), who live isolated, frail, angry and suffer alone











The aims of the project

The project opportunities

I TRAVEL TOO aims to provide the families with a disabled person the opportunity to

- Escape from a difficult and complicated everyday life, experiencing some days of harmony, security and family uniqueness;
- Have an organized transport with all the first aid equipment that a
 disabled person might need, without any anxiety for the devices and
 the encumbrance in the car;
- Have everything one might need to travel from one region to another for hospitalization, a medical consultation or even only a moment of relax with the whole family.





Who benefits of the project?

Many children with severe or very severe disability suffer of such an unstable health condition that they cannot leave their homes **even for attending school**.

I TRAVEL TOO is a great opportunity, that would allow families to finally get out of their houses and let their children explore the world, see the colors of nature, the sky and the depth of the sea.

Thanks to the project many disabled children and their families will be able to travel and see unexplored places, in total safety and security, due to a special vehicle built and equipped on the basis of their needs. Last but not least, the prices of such an important service are affordable.

The project also includes telemedicine assistance with a pediatric nurse and a doctor, who can help the family remotely by a video call.



How to support us

With your support we will be able to start the project immediately, answering the increasing need of families with severely or very severely disabled persons!
